Member, Family And Shared Skater Accounts

Every skater can only have one PRIMARY ACCOUNT HOLDER. Any volunteer credits given for volunteering over the minimum amount will be added to the account of the PRIMARY ACCOUNT HOLDER. Any FINES for not meeting the minimum volunteer hours will also be charged to the PRIMARY ACCOUNT HOLDER. Please see descriptions of types of accounts below:

Member Account

- Member accounts in Uplifter generally refer to the account created by a parent or guardian. It can, however, pertain to the skater themselves (if they are age of majority or otherwise handling their own account).
- A member account will contain address information, a list of invoices, a list of family members, as well as connect all skater profiles within the family.

Family Accounts

- Being part of the same family means you can see each other's participants, as well as register them for programs. This is often useful for mothers and fathers that have separate accounts, but wish to use the same participants.
- All members within the same account can view invoices and use gift certificates owned by any other member of the account.
- Members in the account will not be able to use or see other family members payment information
- This type of account should be used by family members that are amicable with each other

Member Accounts With Shared Skater or Skaters

Members (parent or guardian) can also share a skater or skaters without having
to be in the same family account. This is ideal for parents or guardians that may
want to share a skater in their account but don't want to share all the skaters in
